The Judging Process

The committee was comprised of highly qualified representatives from sectors relating to the different National Standards for Childminders and award categories.

An initial review a total of 117 files of childminders qualified for the Excellence Award, guided by a brief on each one. Following this initial review, a group of 20 childminders was shortlisted. The next critical phase involved unannounced visits to the shortlisted child care facilities on Mahe and Praslin. During those visits, each committee member evaluated specific standard(s) in line with the sector they represent. The committee then met to evaluate and deliberate, compile ratings using a point system, and calculate percentages for each facility.

Overall Impression

The committee was highly impressed by the level of professionalism demonstrated by many childminders. Ms. Daniella described the transformation of their homes into dedicated child care facilities as a "prestigious" effort.

So impressed were the committee members that they introduced a special Judges' Choice Award. This new addition was createc to recognize childminders who demonstrated exceptional compliance and excellence in specific national standards, even if they were not the overall highest scorers across all criteria.

This initiative will surely help to elevate the quality of child care services in the next edition of the awards and will also encourage practicing childminders to register their services with IECD.
